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Part I – Introduction

The Deep East Texas Regional Review Committee (DETRRC) Guidebook has been prepared in accordance with the TxCDBG Action Plan and the 2017-2018 Regional Review Committee Scoring and Training Guidelines for the Community Development Fund. The Guidebook provides eligible applicants from the Deep East Texas Council of Governments (DETCOG) region with the application guidelines necessary to be scored under the DETRRC scoring criteria.

PART II – DETRRC Approved Actions

- 1. The DETRRC held its required Public Hearing on June 30, 2016, to hear Public comments on the proposed objective scoring criteria, and to approve the RRC Guidebook, project priorities and the objective scoring criteria.
- 2. The DETRRC selected the Deep East Texas Council of Governments as support staff to develop and disseminate the RRC Guidebook and calculate the RRC scores and provide other administrative RRC support.
- 3. The RRC established First Priority Projects as Water, Sewer, Streets, Roads, Bridges and Drainage.

Also established Second Priority Projects as All Other Eligible TxCDBG project activities, with the exception of excluding Affordable New Housing, or Homeownership Assistance, or Public Housing Modernization activities.

- 4. The RRC established the maximum grant amounts for the region:
 - Single Jurisdiction: \$275,000.00
 - Multi-Jurisdictions: \$350,000.00
- 5. The RRC did not establish set-asides for housing and non-border colonia projects.

PART III – DETRRC Summary of Objective Scoring Criteria

Total points by DETRRC: **<u>180 points</u>**

- 1. Project Type/Priority: Total Points 160
 - First Priority **160 points**
 - Second Priority –156 points
- 2. Previous Funding: Total Points 20

PART IV – DETRRC Objective Scoring Criteria

Project Type/Priority – 160 Total Points

Scoring Factor:

1. Is the project categorized as:

- i. First Priority project: Water, Sewer, Streets, Roads, Bridges and Drainage 160 Points
- ii. Second Priority project: all other TxCDBG eligible activities except for Affordable New Housing, Homeownership Assistance, or Public Housing Modernization activities which are considered ineligible activities

METHODOLOGY: CD application Table 1 and Table 2 will be reviewed to determine the appropriate project type category and points will be assigned.

Although, Water, Sewer, Streets, Roads, Bridges & Drainage are considered First Priority and all eligible TxCDBG activities are considered under the Second Priority (Note: Ineligible Activities are, Affordable New Housing, Homeownership Assistance, and Public Housing Modernization), TDA will review all activities to determine eligibility and compliance with a national objective.

Applications with multiple activities that are not in the same priority will have their score pro-rated based upon the TxCDBG construction dollars associated with each activity.

Applicants that received partial or marginal funding will be considered having received funding.
