

First Priority	Flood Drainage Improvements (03I), Water/Sewer Improvements (03J), Street Improvements (03K), Rehab. Single-Unit Water or Sewer Services (14A)	50 Points
Second Priority	Clearance and Demolition (04) and Code Enforcement (15)	40 Points
Third Priority	All other project types, including other types of housing rehabilitation projects under 14A	25 Points
