

***Drywood Termite Post-Construction Treatment Disclosure
For Each Estimate***

When an estimate or proposal for termite treatment is submitted to a consumer the PCO must provide the following written disclosure information: a detailed diagram showing exactly what will be treated, the exact treatment specifications, terms of the warranty or guarantee, and chemical label. Treatment specifications, warranties and guarantees can be widely varied; therefore, the consumer is advised to review all this information and the pesticide label for explanations of the treatment proposed in comparison to any other proposal or estimate they may receive.

Definitions of Treatment

A drywood termite or related insect treatment may be a full treatment or limited treatment. These types of treatments are defined as follows:

Full Treatment

Generally defined as a treatment to control 100 percent of the insect infestation by tarpaulin fumigation or appropriate sealing method. A full treatment by fumigation is designed to eliminate every insect colony, both accessible and inaccessible. It should include the infested structure and all attached structures. Tarpaulin fumigation reaches every part of a structure that may not be reached by other approved methods.

Limited Treatment

Any treatment less than full treatment. A treatment which has a limited and defined area that is intended to protect a specific location. Often there are adjacent areas susceptible to drywood termite or related insect infestations that are not treated. Because of the nature of wood destroying insects, these untreated areas may continue to harbor drywood termites and unrelated insects throughout the structure without detection.

For all treatments there will be a graph showing exactly what will be treated. Treatment specifications and warranties for those treatments may vary widely. Review the pesticide label provided to you for minimum treatment specification.
